## Shooting Information

As before this is intended to be a low key shoot and as such events may be changed or deleted as time or weather dictates.

1. **Ear and Eye Protection Mandatory**
2. Black Powder propellant only
3. Open sights: V or U (apertures OK for Long Range)
4. No Spotting Scopes or other modern aids
5. Should be able to walk and load from the body for one or possibly two ML events
6. Ammo Required minimum 25 Rounds Rifle, 15 Rd's Pistol, 15 Rd's Lever Action, 18 Rd's Long Range and 10 Rd' Shotgun
7. It is also intended to run a lever action open event (10 x Rd's) using any propellant  
the only requirements are "no scopes", "cast lead Projectiles" and the rifle must have a magazine.
